Care and Maintenance Instructions

- **1.** Clean up spills immediately using a clean damp cloth or sponge, then dry surface.
- Use any mild common dishwashing liquid. Avoid using cleansers that contain bleach, ammonia, or abrasives.
- Routine cleaning will maintain and help prevent long-term damage to the wood finish.
- Avoid excess water and moisture that can damage wood finishes. Keep surfaces dry.
- 5. Try to avoid direct sunlight. Wood finishes that are exposed to direct sunlight could lighten or darken over time.
- 6. Avoid extremes in temperature and humidity which can cause wood to expand and contract and eventually damage the wood finish.

IRS - Annual Electronic Filing Requirement for Small Exempt Organizations — Form 990-N (e-Postcard)

Most small tax-exempt organizations whose annual gross receipts are normally \$50,000 or less are required to electronically submit Form 990-N, also known as the e-Postcard, unless they choose to file a complete Form 990 or Form 990-EZ instead.

The e-Postcard is due every year by the 15th day of the 5th month after the close of your tax year. For example, if your tax year ended on December 31, the e-Postcard is due May 15 of the following year. If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the due date is the next business day. You cannot file the e-Postcard until after your tax year ends.
